

COVID-19 Exclusion Guidance Decision Tree for Symptomatic People

| Situation | Return to School | Required Documentation | Siblings & Household Members |
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| Positive COVID-19 Test (with or without symptoms) | The local county health department will provide instruction about when it is safe to return to school | None. The local county health department will communicate this information to the school | The local county health department will provide instruction to siblings and household members about when it is safe to return to school |
| Close contact (within 6 feet for a total of 15 minutes) with someone with confirmed COVID-19 | After 14-day quarantine if individual never developed symptoms. If individual develops symptoms, refer to the symptomatic scenarios. The individual must quarantine for 14 days after contact with the COVID-19 positive person even if the student has an alternative diagnosis for symptoms or tests negative. | None | Siblings and household members may stay in school, unless the sibling or household member develops symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19 during quarantine period |
| COVID-19 symptoms with confirmed alternative diagnosis (e.g. GI Illness, strep throat) | Per medical provider guidance and after 24 hours fever free without fever-reduction medication and improvement of symptoms | Written documentation from licensed medical provider that symptoms were caused by a condition other than COVID-19 | Siblings and household members should be excluded from school until alternative diagnosis is determined |
| COVID-19 symptoms with negative COVID-19 test after symptom onset | After 24 hours fever free without fever- reducing medication and improvement of symptoms | Documentation of a negative COVID-19 PCR test obtained after onset of symptoms. Individual must NOT have had a positive COVID-19 test during this illness | Siblings and household members should be excluded from school until confirmation of the negative COVID-19 test and they do not develop any symptoms consistent with COVID-19 |
| COVID-19 symptoms AND No testing | After 10-day isolation from the date symptoms began AND 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medication AND improvement in symptoms | None | Siblings and household members will need to remain home for 14-day quarantine and monitor for symptoms |
